Students learn clinical skills at Sharif Medical City Hospital, a 500-bed hospital with 18730 sq. ft. of covered area. It has separate sections for emergency, outpatients, inpatients, operation theaters, investigation services, and private rooms. There are 13 well-designed and fully equipped operation theaters have their own pre- and post-operative sections. The intensive care facilities range from intensive monitoring to continuous ventilation.

As a tertiary care hospital, this hospital is designed to provide health care of international standards to all patients of the area and others coming from surrounding districts.

The emergency and trauma center of the hospital is dedicated to provide the community with first-class emergency care. The department offers high-quality 24/7 emergency services and caters for the treatment of all acute illnesses as well as life-threatening conditions.

Policies for Generic BSc. Nursing & Post RN BSc. Nursing

Enrollment/Examination

All students are required to be enrolled with the Pakistan Nursing and Midwifery Council (PN&MC) and the University of Health Sciences (UHS). The enrollment, admission, and examination fees will be paid by the students themselves.

Attendance:

All students require a minimum of 85% lectures in all subjects and 100% at the clinical site. If they are less than 85%, they will not be allowed to sit in the UHS examination.



Dress Code:

According to Pakistan Nursing Council Rules and Regulations, the following dress code is followed during college hours:

1. Female Students:

- White trouser, white shirt with full sleeves, white half coat with half sleeves
- Monogram of the institution on one pocket.
- The shirt should be appropriate in length and well suited to our cultural requirements.
- Black shoes and black socks.
- In winter, a dark green jersey or coat

2. Male Students:

- Pant, dress shirt, and shoes (Open-toed shoes are not allowed.)
- In winter, a dark green jersey or coat
- On clinical days, white pants and white shirts with the institution monogram on the pocket. Two green strips on the white collar of the shirt.

Clinical duties during the semester:

1. 1st and 2nd years: no night or evening duties. Students will perform morning duties under the supervision of a clinical instructor.
2. 3rd and 4th years: 1 month Morning, evening, and night duties are under the supervision of shift supervisors and head nurses.

Leave policy:

A student can take 30 days of leave each year (including sick leave and medical rest). Within the probationary period (first three months), students cannot avail any leave.

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) 02-Years Diploma Program

This course is for females only. Formerly, this course was titled Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). The program offers knowledge, skills, and a professional attitude at a lower cost as compared to RN. Upon completion of this program, the CNA will be a safe clinical nurse who can provide care at primary, secondary, and tertiary levels in association with RNs in hospitals and community settings.



Admission Criteria

Applicant must meet one of the following academic levels:

- FSc (Pre-Medical) with 45% marks minimum (Physics, Chemistry & Biology as compulsory subjects)
- Matric (Science) with 45 % marks minimum (Physics, Chemistry & Biology as compulsory subjects)
- Matric (Arts) with 50% marks, FA with 50% Marks
- Age Limit: 14-35 years

Policies for Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

Attendance Policy

1. Theory Classes: According to the PN & MC rule, students are expected to maintain 100% attendance in all theory classes. However, in cases of emergency or sickness, students may miss up to 15% (cumulative) of classes. If a student misses more than 15% (cumulative), she may be asked to repeat the semester/term/year or withdrawn or expelled from the program.
2. In each academic year, students are allowed annual leave of one calendar month.

Note: Sick leave of seven days is permissible; any leave beyond this will be deducted from annual leaves.

1. **Clinical/Skills Lab** Students are expected to maintain 100% attendance during clinical classes. Students will require making up any absences in clinical areas.



2. In case of emergency or sickness, students may miss up to 4 days (cumulative) of clinical classes.

Enrollment/Nursing Examination Board (NEB):

- All students are required to be enrolled by the Pakistan Nursing and Midwifery Council (PN&MC) and the Nursing Examination Board (NEB).

Duties:

- First Year = No Night Duties
- Second Year: One month of night duty under the supervision of senior staff or the head nurse.

Uniform policy:

- As per PN & MC white shalwar, shirt with half sleeves and pink head cover

Hostel Facilities and Rules

Hostel accommodation is available for those students who need it. The hostel is situated within the college premises and is entirely safe for students. Residing students have to follow hostel rules and regulations, otherwise, hostel facilities will be withdrawn. A copy of the rules and regulations will be provided to the students at the time of acquiring the hostel.

Note: Hostel rules are purely for students' safety and violations of these rules will be dealt with disciplinary action.

Visiting Days and Timings

No visitors are allowed in hostel rooms.

All visitors are to be entertained only in the visitor's room during visiting hours. Parents or guardians will nominate visitors and provide their photographs and copies of the CNIC in the principal office and to the hostel warden. Only those visitors will be allowed to visit the students who have been nominated by their parents or guardians.



No visitors will be entertained during college timings and duty hours.
