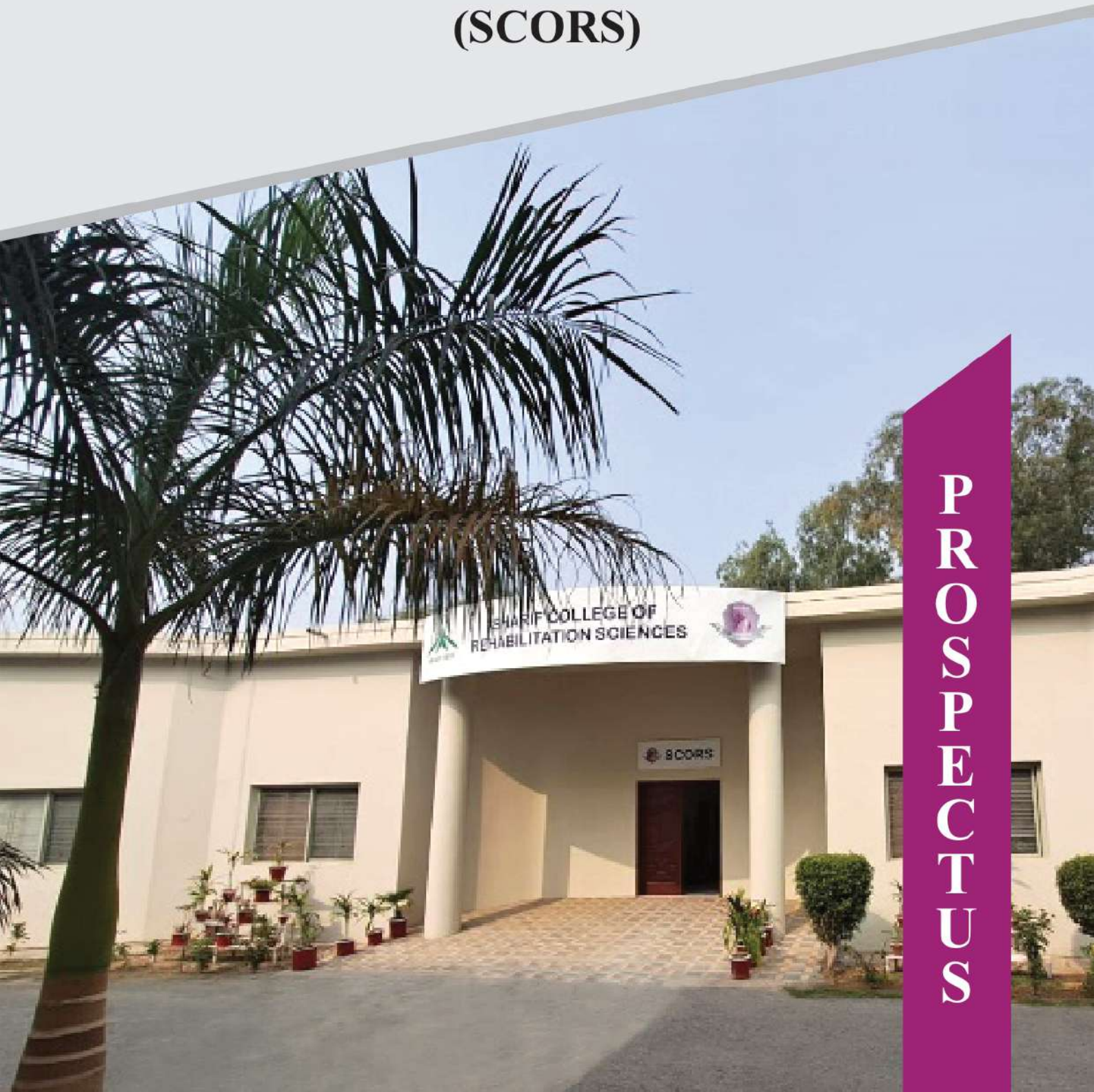

- The attendance and academic performance of non-examination subjects being taught in a year will be carried forward to the year of examination, where cumulative attendance of all years in which the subject has been taught shall be considered for determining eligibility to appear in the Professional Examination.

## **2. Attendance Shortage during the Academic Year**

If the attendance of a student falls below 75%, a warning letter shall be issued. During any term, if the cumulative attendance in any subject falls short up to 50% the student shall be suspended from attending the classes. Permission to attend classes shall be subject to the meeting of the parents with the Principal and undertaking by the students and parents that this won't be repeated again.

## **C. PAYMENT OF DUES**

1. Tuition fee and other charges are:
  - a. Payable in advance in full before the start of the academic year as per notified due date.
  - b. To be paid at the Habib Bank, Sharif City Branch by deposit challan obtainable from the Account Section, Sharif Medical and Dental College, Lahore.
2. Admission fee once paid is not refundable.
3. The dates for payment of the fee are fixed and are notified at the beginning of year.
4. The College Administration does not take any responsibility of sending reminders to parents/guardian to pay the College dues.
5. College dues shall be paid before the notified due date
  - I. Delayed payment of College dues after the due date carries a fine for the 30 days after due date.
  - II. In cases of non-payment of fee 30 days of due date (without a valid informed reason), the name of the student shall be struck off from the College roll and readmission on college roll will be subject to approval from the competent authority.
6. Students will not be allowed to appear in University Examination unless all dues are fully cleared prior to the University Examination.
7. Detained Students:

There shall be no extra tuition fee for supplementary examination. The students repeating the year on account of being debarred from University Examination shall be charged full yearly tuition fee. The detained students shall be charged tuition fee in proportion to the number of failed subjects of that professional examination as prescribed by the UHS.

## **E. HOSTEL**

1. Hostel Accommodation is subject to availability and first come first serve basis.
2. Students residing in Hostels must strictly abide by the notified regulations (Hostel Regulation Booklet). Failure of compliance shall lead to penalty ranging from fine to immediate expulsion from the Hostel.
3. Hostel dues:
  - a. Are to be paid in advance on a six-month basis.
  - b. Use of electric appliances like electric iron, fridge, air-conditioner etc. is subject to prior permission from the Principal and carries additional specific charges.
  - c. Delayed payment of hostel charges after the due date carries fine as per college rules.

## **F. CODE OF CONDUCT**

- Cheating, social misconduct or infractions of college rules; stealing, willful destruction of college property; use of physical force against other students, patients or staff, use of drugs, possession or use of weapons, inciting disturbance or strikes; and/or repeated absence from classes and clinics without sanctioned leave will be referred to the College Disciplinary Committee; which after investigation will recommend appropriate action. It may even result in removal of students' name from the college rolls.
- Students are expected to attend all classes, demonstrations, practical and clinical teaching sessions. Student Attendance & Academics record is properly maintained by the respective teaching departments and Student Affair Section of the College Secretariat. A copy of students' attendance record of each trimester is posted to parents/guardian for their information and feedback from them.
- Students shall not be granted leave of absence on working days except in case of an emergency. All leave applications must be addressed to the Principal in writing for sanction.
- Any student continuous absence of 4 weeks from the College without sanctioned leave would lead to striking off his/her name from college rolls. Re-admission would only be allowed after obtaining an NOC from the Principal for re-admission.
- Students are expected to take care of College / Hospital property. Any damage caused by the students will be charged in full to the students involved in such mischief.
- The College is not responsible for loss of any valuables during a student's tenure at the College. Students are expected to safeguard their own belongings.
